


Role Profile



Main responsibilities, focusing on the required outputs:

- To complete all aspects of a new Fire Alarm systems including; producing a bill of materials from CAD drawings, producing a list of tooling needed to complete the installation, 1st and 2nd fixing of an FA system, testing and commissioning and producing as built drawings.
- Coaching and developing less experienced colleagues by passing on knowledge and experience.
- Assist the electrical team members with electrical installs.
- Developing knowledge and skills with fire alarm systems and technology as the team's expert in this field.
- Leading the provision of IT, tooling, equipment and work instructions relevant to air conditioning projects
- Keeping all training up to date.
- Provide feedback on individual project progress to allow the PM to inform customers and stakeholders.
- Provide the specialist knowledge in the construction phase of the project to the PM to support planning activities.
- Liaise with the Design Engineers to ensure that the plans/designs can be built/installed.
- Reactive maintenance and repairs of Fire alarm installations.
- Complete risk assessment and method statements.
- Maintaining new and existing building Fire Alarm installations.
- Carry out diagnostic checks and fault finding.
